## Summary

Starting Monday, November 2, 2015, the following service changes impacting public transportation to Concrete will go into effect:

- 1. Flex Route 8 to Concrete will be replaced by Fixed Route 717 and complementary paratransit service.
- 2. Skagit Transit will begin offering one additional morning round trip per weekday to Concrete.
- 3. Route 717 will begin operating on a new schedule and altered route.
- 4. Local fares will be charged on Route 717 \$1 Regular, \$0.50 Youth, and \$0.50 Reduced or Disabled. One-day and 31-day passes are also available.
- 5. Several new bus stops will be installed in Sedro-Woolley.
- 6. Minor schedule changes to Flex Route 750 to Marblemount

A revised Rider Guide will go into distribution no later than one-week prior to the service change going into effect.

## What's the Difference between Flex and Fixed Routes?

Currently, transit service to Concrete is provided by Flex Route 8 (3 round trips per day) and Fixed Route 717 (2 round trips per day). Starting November 2, 2015, all service to Concrete will be provided by Fixed Route 717. Unlike Flex Route 8, the Route 717 bus **does not travel** off of its designated route to pick up or drop off passengers. Passengers living within ¾ of a mile of Route 717 but whose conditions and/or disabilities prevent them from using fixed route service, should contact 360-757-4433 to discuss ADA Paratransit Service. Eligibility for Paratransit service is based on the review of an application in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990.

## **Bus Fare**

Starting November 2, 2015, transit service to Concrete will be operated by Fixed Route 717 and complementary paratransit service. Standard local fare is required on Route 717. Passengers unfamiliar with Skagit Transit's fare system should refer to the table below. - Purchasing Bus Fare: Purchase fare on the bus, at Skagit Station in Mount Vernon, at 600 County Shop Lane in Burlington, or through the mail by calling Skagit Transit at (360) 757-8801.
- Value Cards: You can purchase a value card in the amount of \$1, \$2, \$4, \$8, \$12 and \$20 at Skagit Station or by mail.
- · Children 7 and under ride free!
- Youth are riders age 8 through 17 or high school students in possession of a valid high school identification card.
- County Connector Passes are valid on ALL Skagit Transit and WTA bus routes.
- Cash Change is not given on Skagit Transit buses. Please have exact change ready or request a change card valid for future transit fare.
- Remember to have bus fare ready before boarding.

# Schedule and Route Changes: 717 to Concrete

Starting November 2, 2015, bus service to Concrete will be performed by Route 717. Route 717 will make six round trips per weekday and two round trips per Saturday. This includes a new morning round trip to Concrete! Except for a morning express run, Route 717 will travel to Cedar Grove as part of its regular route. The bus will only stop at Pressentin Creek by request. Pressentin passengers will need to call Skagit Transit Dispatch (360-757-4433) at least 2 hours before their bus is scheduled to depart the Sedro-Woolley Park and Ride. 


Figure 1. Map showing the western half of Route 717 as it will operate starting November 2, 2015.




Figure 2. Map showning the eastern half of Route 717 as it will operate starting November 2, 2015.




Figure 3. No changes have been made to bus routing through the town of Concrete.

# New Route 717 Bus Stops

A handful of new bus stops will be installed to allow more convenient access to popular locations in Sedro-Woolley. New stops will be located at:

- The intersection of Wicker and Township near the Cascade Christian Church.
- On State Street near Ball Street at the Sedro Woolley Senior Center (westbound stop) and at the Liberty Bell Market (eastbound).
- On Trail Road near the intersection of Trail and Cook Roads.
- On Trail Road mid-way between Highway 20 and Cook Road.
