CHUCKANUT PARK AND RIDE HVAC AND GENERATOR UPGRADES, IFB 21-001-P

The Contract provides for the construction of generator and HVAC upgrades at the Chuckanut Park and Ride. The Work includes constructing a concrete pad for the generator, demolishing existing electrical features, upgrading electrical wiring, installing a new heat pump, constructing a chain link security cage, and erosion control measures. The time limit for project completion is a total of 20 WORKING DAYS.

The Engineer's opinion of probable construction cost range is \$155,000 to \$175,000. Bids shall be submitted only on the forms provided in the Project Manual. All bids must include a Bid Bond made only on an Owner-provided form for a sum equal to 5% of the Total Bid Amount.

A non-mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting and site visit is scheduled for 10:00 PDT Tuesday, January 18th, 2022 at the existing building at Chuckanut Park and Ride lot, located at 321 Hansen Place, Burlington, WA.

Free-of-charge access to project Bid Documents will be provided to Prime Bidders, Subcontractors, and Vendors by going to Builders Exchange at www.bxwa.com and selecting "Posted Projects", "Public Works", and "Skagit Transit". It is recommended that Bidders "Register" in order to receive automatic e-mail notification of future Addenda and to place themselves on the "Self-Registered Bidders List". Bidders that do not register will not be automatically notified of Addenda and will need to periodically check the on-line plan room for Addenda issued on this Project.
