4. Public Comment

Joe Kunzler addressed the committee regarding:

- Legal clarity around transit rider representation and employee eligibility
- Expressed desire to serve as interim rider representative if needed
- Encouraged CAC discussion on flood evacuation performance and rider experience

The Committee acknowledged comments and noted follow-up is underway.

6. Skagit Transit Staff Update - Maleah Kuzminsky

Ridership (November 2025):

Fixed Route: 41,533 riders (↑ 8.09% year-over-year)

Paratransit: 6,417 riders (↑ 12.44%)

Key Updates:

- Selection of Spare Labs software for Paratransit & future Microtransit pilot, to provide: accessible rider app, multilingual capability, and improved scheduling and capacity optimization.
- Discussion of staffing challenges related to long-term leaves and overtime
- Anticipated certification of Automatic Passenger Counters (APCs) enabling detailed boarding data and heat maps
- Microtransit identified as potential strategy to improve efficiency and service in low-density areas
- Improved ridership could unlock additional state funding.

7. Committee Discussion

Topics included:

- Challenges comparing Skagit Transit to peer agencies due to rural/urban mix

- Importance of increasing service frequency on connector routes
- East County service gaps (e.g., 70X)
- Driver recruitment ideas, including partnerships with colleges and targeted marketing
- Value of CAC members engaging riders directly for feedback

8. Old Business

Follow-up on Public Comment (Liam Diephuis – prior meeting):

- Operations reviewed concerns regarding transfers at Chuckanut
- No specific incident identified due to lack of time details
- Encouragement for riders to report future incidents promptly

9. New Business – Bylaws Review (Draft Recommendations)

Three proposed changes were discussed:

- New Member Orientation

Consensus to make orientation a joint responsibility of the CAC Chair *and* Staff Liaison

- Meeting Recordings

Remove outdated language requiring backup audio recordings by Special Projects Assistant

- Officer Nominations Process

Discussion revealed need for clearer distinction and timeline between:

Recommendations vs. Nominations

Decision: Further refinement required

- Action: Table final decision for future meeting

- Draft recommendation regarding transit rider representation on the Skagit Transit Board distributed for review. To be discussed at a future meeting after Chair consultation with Board Chair.
