Skagit Transit acquired a former distribution warehouse facility to address capacity constraints of the current base of operations resulting from the addition of regional and expanded local transportation services. The facility will be reprogrammed to meet the agency's immediate and future capacity needs.

The facility will be the base for all Skagit Transit's maintenance, operations and administrative support activities.

The construction of the project will be completed in three phases.

Phase One construction is underway and is estimated to be complete by February 2024.

Phase Two can begin as Phase One wraps up in early 2024.

Phase Three can begin in 2024, as funding permits, the construction activities will continue for approximately one year.

Phase Three will complete the renovation construction of the facility.

The project site was purchased in 2015, it includes a pre-engineered, steel fabricated building with a concrete floor which was constructed in 2004 and expanded in 2008.

On-site improvements include truck trailer parking, staff and visitor parking, fencing, security lighting, cameras, and storm water detention.

When complete the facility will support all Skagit Transit operations and will include a public meeting room, electric vehicle infrastructure for visitors, staff and transit vehicles, energy efficient heating and cooling.

Project Budget

Land and Facility Purchase - \$6.1 million

Architect Engineering and Environmental Planning - \$4 million

Phase One Construction - \$5.7 million

Phase Two Construction - \$13 million

Phase Three Construction - \$16.5 million

Acquisition of location site, architect, engineering and environmental permitting have been completed.

The project is currently in phase one of construction.

Phase Two funding is secured.

Phase Three - \$6 million secured

Skagit Transit, Washington State DOT and the Federal Transit Administration are current financial contributors to the project.
